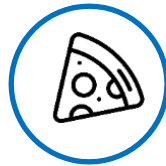

### CANDY CANE GRAMS

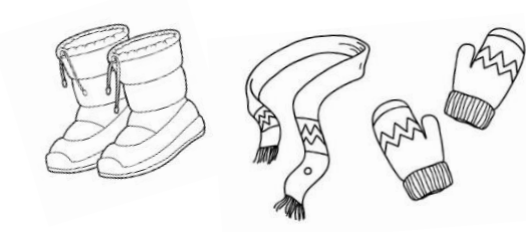
