CODING & STEAM NIGHT

Thanks to all who came out to CSPC's coding and STEAM night on April 15th. In addition to several CSPC members, we are grateful to the following, who came together to contribute some awesome ideas, time, and/or equipment for some fun learning activities: Michelle Mifsud, John Toffoli, Mekdes Woleld, Ezana Mamo, Andrew Morgan, Josh Clifton, Ed Kim and the Pink Titans, members of the St Brigid A/V club, some awesome Notre Dame physics students, Mr. Colla, and Ms. Falsetti.

We were able to accommodate a little over 120 kids, plus adults, plus some staff members, and it was good fun for all. We also collected \$415 that will go toward the tech fund, and gained some fun projects and materials that can now be used by classes as well!

CSPC FINANCIAL UPDATE

Since our last update in January, parent-raised funds have been used to purchase:

- classroom items (only those not covered by the Board),
- more scientist/STEM workshops,
- a class set of Microbits that can be signed out for use,
- -other tech,
- hot chocolate and buses for Skate day,
- a new set of team shirts for sports and other teams (These remain at school for all children don't have their own to use),
- pancakes and fruit for school-wide Shrove Tuesday celebration,
- some A/V equipment for school assemblies,
- deposits on Inflatables and a few fun surprises for Fun Fair,
- January's parent math talk (from parent-specific grant money),
- coffee for April 10 morning "volunteer chat" (parent-specific money),
- bank fees and other administrative costs.

Upcoming expenses include some of the above, plus a few already booked communal things such as bussing for the Festival of Trees (Grade 3-8 students who opted in to the extra reading opportunity through Forest of Reading – thanks to Ms. Peddler for running that), Rocks and Rings workshops (K-8 Phys Ed fun – thanks to Ms. Collins-Donleavy and the Phys Ed teachers for coordinating that), and items for sacraments and graduation.
